The above referenced vendor has provided the appropriate plan review, license fee, menu and operational details to the Mesa County Health Department for approval. This vendor meets the requirements to operate in Mesa County. Any change in menu, operation or commissary revokes this approval.

The vendor is approved to operate at the following types of events:

Special Event: A single community event or celebration that operates for a period of time of not more than 14 consecutive days and may include town celebrations, fairs, festivals and farmer's markets. Examples are Fruita Fall Fest, Pork and Hops, JUCO, etc.

The vendor is approved to serve the following menu: **Turkey legs, gator/sausage/chicken on a stick, pork chop, boudain balls, popcorn shrimp, eggroll, blooming onion, fried pickles, ribbon fries, nachos with cheese, French fries, corn, water, soda, lemonade.**

Commissary and location:

The vendor does not have a commissary in Mesa County. Mobile unit is a part of the temporary event set up therefore they have facilities to clean utensils on the mobile unit. All food preparation (washing, cutting, slicing, dicing, etc.) must be conducted in the mobile unit. Assembly and cooking may take place outside of the unit. All foods must be sold through the mobile unit.
