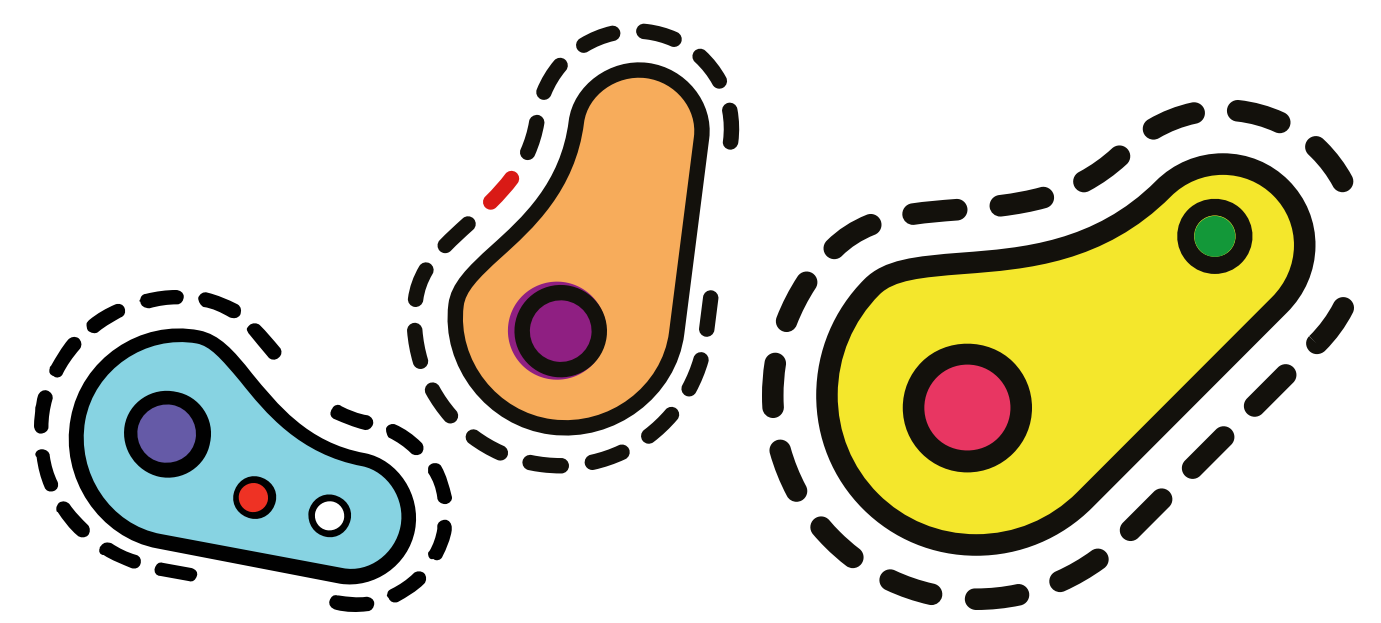


HEPATITIS A



WHAT IS HEP A?

It's a disease that affects the liver and can be spread through food and drinks. Food handlers aren't more likely to get hepatitis A, but they are at a higher risk of spreading it to others.

HOW DOES IT SPREAD?

Usually when a person ingests fecal matter - even in small amounts - from contact with objects, food, or drinks contaminated with feces from an infected person.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- **Get the hepatitis A vaccination**

- **Practice good hand-washing**

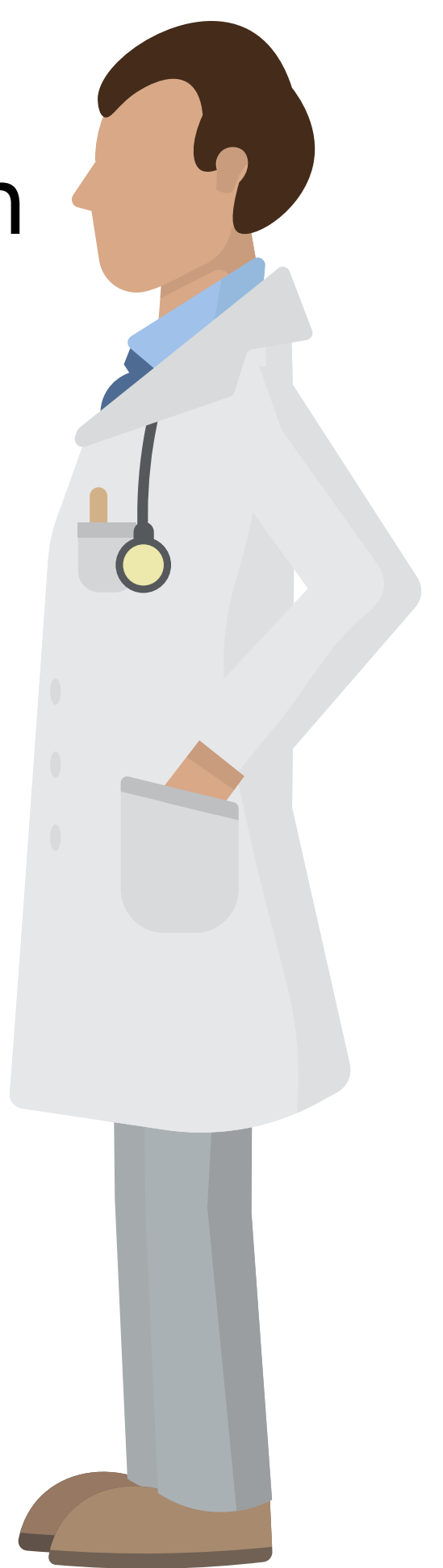
especially after using the restroom.
