The above referenced vendor has provided the appropriate plan review, license fee, menu and operational details to the Mesa County Health Department for approval. This vendor meets the requirements to operate in Mesa County. Any change in menu, operation or commissary revokes this approval.

The vendor is approved to operate at the following types of events:

Special Event: A single community event or celebration that operates for a period of time of not more than 14 consecutive days and may include town celebrations, fairs, festivals and farmer's markets. Examples are Fruita Fall Fest, Pork and Hops, JUCO, etc.


The vendor is approved to serve the following menu: **Hand-dipped ice cream, prepackaged nuts, kettlecorn, root bear**

Commissary and location:

The vendor does not have a commissary in Mesa County and is required to clean all equipment and utensils before arriving. Vendor has agreed to bring enough utensils and also use disposable containers to be sufficient for the entire event and does not need a commissary. Vendor is not approved to wash any equipment during the event. All food preparation (washing, cutting, slicing, dicing, etc.) must be conducted at the commissary prior to arrival. Food handling at the event is limited to cooking, assembling and serving.
