The vendor is approved to operate at the following types of events:

Special Event: A single community event or celebration that operates for a period of time of not more than 14 consecutive days and may include town celebrations, fairs, festivals and farmer's markets. Examples are Fruita Fall Fest, Pork and Hops, JUCO, etc.

On-Going Program or Sporting Event: Regularly scheduled series of events held at such places as public parks, sporting arenas, concert halls, flea markets, and sporadic promotional events such as grand opening.

The vendor is approved to serve the following menu: **Breakfast burrito, Navajo tacos, taco salad, fried bread, fries, burgers, brats, hot dogs (with toppings), nachos, bloomin' onion, funnel cake, deep fried Twinkies, deep fried fruits, deep fried peanut butter and jelly sandwich, Philly cheese steaks, Italian sausages, Frito pie, and beverages.**

Commissary and location: **This vendor is approved as a self-contained mobile unit with the menu detailed above and is not required to have a commissary in Mesa County. All food preparation, storage and utensil cleaning must take place in the unit. No food storage, preparation or utensil cleaning is allowed in the personal home.**
